VILLAGE OF WAUCONDA LICENSE AND ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE MEETING TUESDAY, MARCH 15, 2016 5:30 P.M.

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 P.M.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of February 16, 2016 were approved.

3. OLD BUSINESS

Continuation of the Committee's comprehensive review of the Village Code.

§ 50.20 Change to read, "It shall be the duty of every owner or his agent or occupant of any house, building, flat or apartment or tenement in the village where people reside, board or lodge, or where animal or vegetable food is prepared or served, and at all times, to maintain in good order and repair, a separate can for garbage and a separate receptacle for tin cans, bottles, ashes and similar refuse. It shall be the duty of every such occupant to deposit nothing but garbage in the ~~can~~ receptacle provided for the same and nothing but ~~tin cans or bottles~~ recyclables in the receptacle provided for the same".

§ 50.22 Remove the words "tin cans and bottles" from this section.

§ 50.25 Add paragraph (E), to read: Trash and recycle receptacles may be put out for pickup at 3:00 p.m. the day before pickup and must be put away the day of pickup.

§ 50.47 (B) Replace 32 gallons with 96 gallons.

Administrator Maxeiner explained that most municipalities maintain code codification

themselves in-house and have a dedicated person to do it. He will research ecode and Municode to price out the transition.

4. NEW BUSINESS

Director Miller gave the committee members a draft of the proposed revised plumbing code. IDNR now has very specific plumbing code requirements for Lake Michigan Water allocated communities that Wauconda must comply with. IDNR also wants the issue of outside sprinkling addressed. The State must approve all plumbing code amendments before approval of the Village Board and Director Miller will take care of getting the State approval and he will speak with Attorney Magna regarding changes to the outside sprinkling issue. It was recommended the even/odd days and addresses should remain in place and that there should be no watering between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

The current fee schedule dated October 20, 2009 was reviewed by the Committee and it was determined the schedule needs to be updated by the appropriate departments.

5. PUBLIC COMMENT

6. ADJOURNMENT

Chairman Howe adjourned the meeting at 6:30 P.M.
