

Adopt a Roadway Application

INSTRUCTIONS: Most Village roadways may be adopted. Assignments will be made on a first come/first served basis. Groups must agree to participate a minimum of three times a year for at least two years. Participants are required to adopt, at a minimum, a 1/2-mile section of road (both sides). A no-fee permit is required to participate in the Adopt-A-Roadway program. A group contact person must be identified for the group. Groups must consist of at least 6 – 10 people, age restrictions apply. Each member of the group must agree to follow the program rules and guidelines. The Village shall retain the right to revoke any permit at any time. The Village of Wauconda will provide, install, and maintain one sign on each side of the section of adopted roadway recognizing the participating group. Missing or vandalized signs will be replaced one time only. Groups failing to follow the guidelines or not meeting the minimum participation requirements will have their sign removed and the roadway will be available for another group to adopt.
