



2011 Parkway Tree Program

Because of the devastating effects of the presence of the Emerald Ash Borer, the Village of Wauconda is proud to reintroduce the Village's Parkway Tree Program and work with residents to beautify the area around their homes. Trees ordered through this program will be fully funded by the resident, but coordinated through the Village with a local vendor. Trees will be planted in the fall, most likely during early October, as weather permits. Three types of trees will be available for purchase — maple, linden and locust. The specific genus of these trees will not be determined until planting time. Trees will be 2 ½ - 3 inches in diameter at breast height.

The Village requires residents to follow certain guidelines for trees planted in the parkway. For this program, trees may **only be planted on the Village owned parkway** and must be planted according to the following guidelines. Trees should be planted:

- at least 35 feet from other parkway trees,
- at least 10 feet from a driveway or street light,
- at least 45 feet from an intersection to ensure unobstructed sight lines,
- at least 5 feet from a manhole, fire hydrant or b-box (water service shut off valve).
- There may also be some limitations on locations under utility wires.

The Village Arborist is available to work with residents to select proper locations as requested. Sorry, no trees may be ordered for private property.
